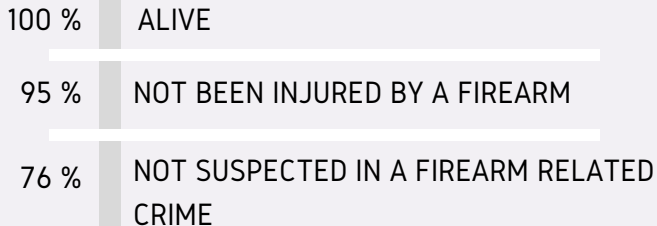

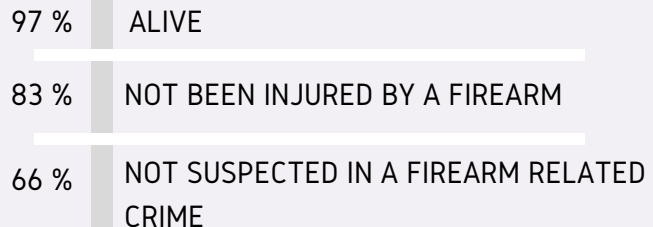

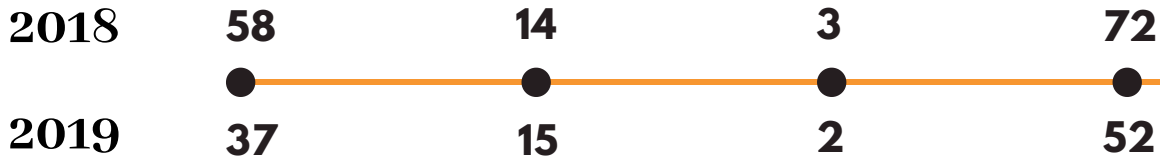


ALL 1 - 6 FELLOWSHIP COHORTS **2010-2019* **127 FELLOWS**
